Fifth cruise ship of the year sailed into Guam today

Piti, Guam, March 21, 2024: The Port Authority of Guam welcomed its fifth passenger vessel of the year with the arrival of the MS Queen Elizabeth this morning.

The MS Queen Elizabeth docked at the Port Authority of Guam at 5:48 a.m. with 1,854 passengers and 1,028 crew members. The cruise ship will depart the port this evening at 6:00 p.m., giving its passengers time to partake in water activities, explore Guam and dine in Hagåtña and Tumon establishments.

"The arrival of the MS Queen Elizabeth and other premier cruise ships underscores the Port of Guam's role in our local and regional economies, aligning with Governor Lou Leon Guerrero and Lt. Governor Josh Tenorio's vision for the Port of Guam," said Port General Manager Rory J. Respicio.

Other potential cruise ship visits to Guam this year include the Le Soleal on March 24th, the Carnival on April 8th, the Seabourn on May 14th and September 7th, the Le Soleal on October 8th, the Carnival on October 22nd, and the MS Asuka II on December 30th.
