Operation “Adai he hão!” (Watch Out!) Implemented by Port Police to deter speeding

Piti, Guam, January 28, 2016: The Port Authority of Guam (PAG) received funding from Department of Public Works, Office of Highway Safety Section 402 Highway Funds, for a new laser speed gun, traffic safety cones, training, and overtime funding for Port Police Personnel during fiscal year 2015.

Throughout our local law enforcement agencies, the PAG Port Police Division (PPD), as well as other local and federal law enforcement agencies have since partnered to ensure safety of our roadways and enhancing the quality of life for the community of Guam to reduce crashes, injuries and fatalities on Guam’s roadways.

In an effort to reduce speeding, crashes related to speeding, reckless driving, imprudent driving and unsafe driving habits, the Port Police Division implemented Operation “Adai he’ hão!” (Watch Out!), that addresses and targets speeding, crashes related to speeding, reckless driving, imprudent driving and unsafe driving habits along the roadways of Route 11 & 18 Cabras Highway & Naval Fuel Dock in Piti, Route 1 – Hågatña, Asan, & Piti, Route 2, 2A – Sumay and Agat by providing high-visibility enforcement during fiscal year 2015.
